Stella wants to be an astronaut.

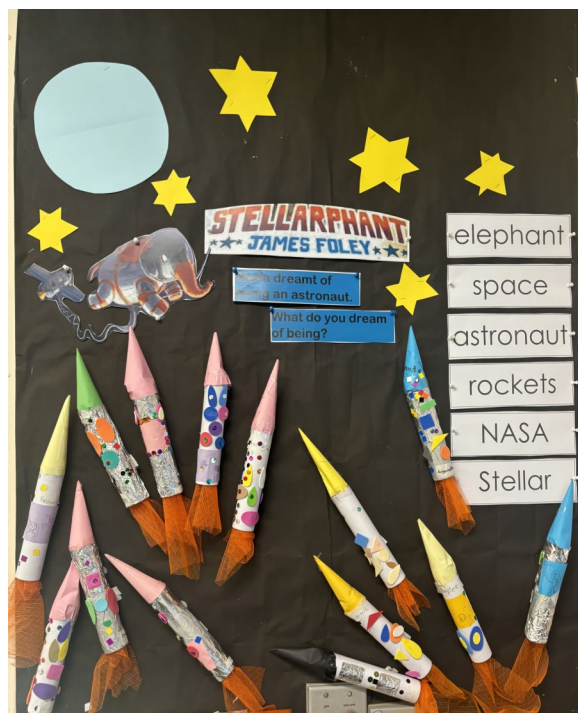
There is only one problem: Stella is an elephant.
