To all our new families, and our new Kindy students who are now starting their learning journey, I hope that you have settled in already and made to feel very welcome to be part of our school community. Remember that my door is always open if you need to come and have a chat or need any clarification on certain school operations. Over the next few weeks, I would like to see if we can organise a "meet & greet" for both new and old families—and then look at ways that we can work together to benefit the students at our school—more news on that soon! We also need a couple more parents on our School Council to add to our parent representatives. Our meetings are held twice a term and are held from 1:45pm—3:00pm so that you don't have to worry about coming out at night which is usually a busy time for families. You are also here to pick up your children after school. Meetings are currently held on a Thursday afternoon. Drop me a line, or come and have a chat if you are interested.

Swimming Lessons: One more week and then these will start for all students from Pre-Primary to Year 6. We strongly encourage all students to attend—after all swimming is one of Australia's favourite pastimes and learning to swim and be able to follow safety skills in the water, is essential. Forms were sent out this week and will need to be returned by next week for your child to attend.
